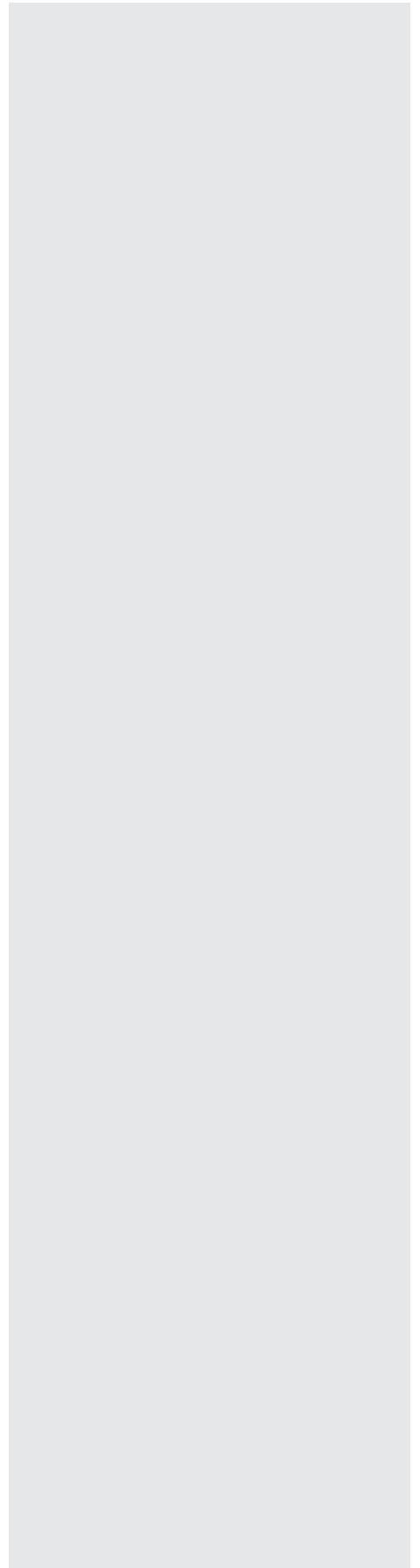

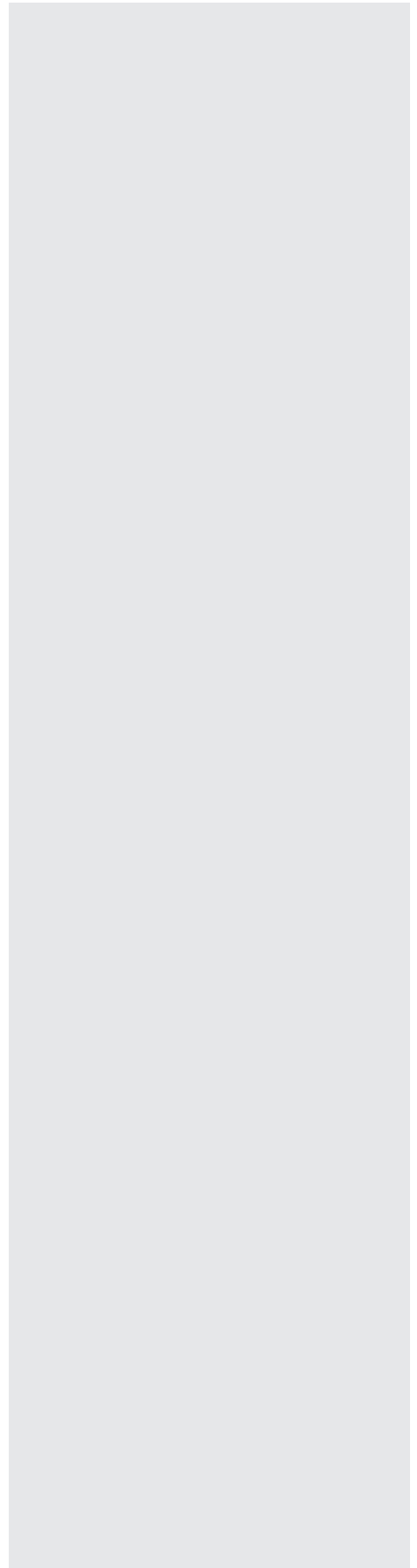
MISCONDUCT ISSUES
